

Guidelines for appropriate use of Eovist

- Focal Nodular Hyperplasia (FNH) - If this is described as a possible diagnosis in the indication or in a prior Radiology exam report, you should use Eovist protocol whether it was ordered or not, and you do not need to call the Radiologist.
- Hemangioma - Eovist should specifically be avoided if this is the working diagnosis.
- Others - HCC (Hepatocellular Carcinoma, aka Hepatoma or liver cancer), Liver metastatic disease, cholangiocarcinoma - You may use Eovist if it was specifically ordered, otherwise do not use. No need to call radiologist. One exception is if they had a liver ablation procedure in the past 3 months, do not use it.
